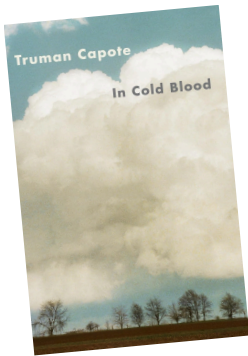


BOOK CLUBS

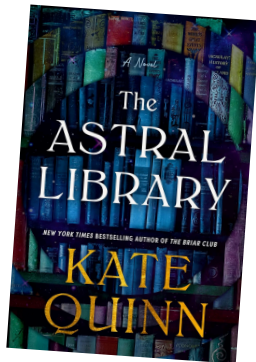

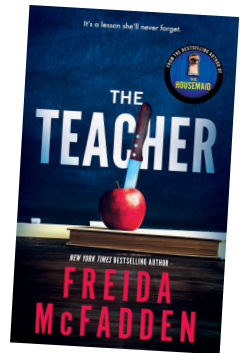


TRENDY TITLES
