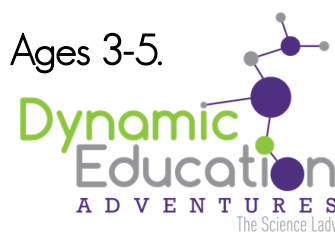

FCML Reads

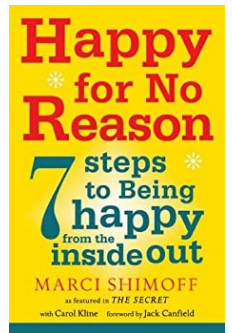
